Plans are not required for the following:

1. One-and two-family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of habital living area
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Assembly, Business, Mercantile, and Storage Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

If work being performed is described above, check box "Plans Not Required."

Plans Not Required

Plan are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

V. Applicant Signature

Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. VIIa. Fee Clarification

Item #2, Mobile Home Unit Site: WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or **modular** home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

Item # 25, Domestic Water Treatment And Filtering Equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #21 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

IX. Instructions for Completing Application

<p>General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Alpine Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the Township with your inspection request and provide as much advance notice as possible. The Township will need the job location and access details, if required.</p>
<p>Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.</p>
