Groups/teams agree not to use the field (s) when deemed unplayable due to rain or other conditions.

Alpine Township employees have the right to order groups/teams from the field (s) at any time because of field conditions or conduct of players.

Groups/teams are responsible to make sure the fields and facilities are clean and picked-up when they leave.

Any violation of the above could result in cancellation of Township Field Use Permit.

Any violation of the following duly adopted township rules and regulations (Ordinance No. 12-01 and Resolution No. 12-05 of February 20, 2012 may be punishable as a misdemeanor with a fine of \$500.00, imprisonment for 90 days, or both, at the discretion of the court.

- (a) A written application and fee is required before a use permit will be issued.
- (b) All Township facilities shall only be used for what they are intended (i.e. walking track, ball fields, volleyball, tennis courts etc.).
- (c) Playing on fields or courts during or after field preparation is not allowed. Authorized personnel of the Township may ask you to leave the area for field preparation.
- (d) Vandalism of any type is unlawful.
- (e) Loitering or playing in bathrooms is not allowed.
- (f) No alcoholic beverages are allowed at any Township facilities.
- (g) No glass bottles or containers are allowed in Township Parks.
- (h) Pets must be on a leash and pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- (i) The speed limit in all Township parks (unless designated otherwise) is 10 MPH for all types of motor vehicles.
- (j) Parking lots are off limits to any activity other than parking motor vehicles unless the activity is granted by a permit.
- (k) No person shall ride or drive any motor vehicle in any park except upon a proper roadway or parking lot.
- (l) Open fires (i.e. campfires) cannot be built in any township park at any time.
- (m) Only approved portable gas grills are allowed for cooking.
- (n) Bleachers or picnic tables are not to be moved or removed from any park.
- (o) Raffles or gambling is not allowed at any Township facility.
- (p) Soliciting in Township parks is prohibited.
