

ORDINANCE NO. 86-1

An Ordinance to Provide for a Reward for Information Leading to Arrest and Conviction for Malicious Destruction of Property

The Charter Township of Alpine ordains:

Section I. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to promote the general peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township by reducing the incidents of malicious destruction of property.

Section II. Reward.

The Township shall pay to any person the sum of Fifty and (\$50.00) Dollars who shall provide information that leads to the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any Township Ordinance that makes it a misdemeanor to willfully destroy, remove, damage, alter, or in any manner deface any property not his or her own.

Section III. Cooperation.

Any such person seeking such reward must have provided such information, must have cooperated with the appropriate law enforcement agencies, and must have either testified or had been willing to testify to such information in Court.

Section IV. Application.

An application for such reward must be filed with the Township Clerk within one (1) year of conviction of any such offender for any such reward to be paid. The application must provide sufficient information so as to enable the Township Board to determine that the reward should be paid as called for above.

Section V. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication.
